

Buffalo River Speedway Short Trackers

2023 Rules Package

- Buffalo River Speedway short Trackers will try and encompass rules that are fair to accommodate several tracks in the area with “home track rules” with some noted exceptions
- No LSD Transmissions
- All DOT Tires-Hoosier Tires will be allowed over a transition period in 2023 as long as the competitor does not race more than ½ of the events scheduled at Buffalo River Speedway
- All items in cockpit or built cockpit must be securely fastened
- No self tapping screws-Rivets must be used to bond body panels together
- Exhaust has to be 2ft off the motor
- Factory Headers are okay
- Throttle body & intake must be stock
- Aero Rims are allowed
- 7” rim rule-offset can be changed
- If battery is in car it must be covered or in a box
- Fuel tank must be safely secured in the car
- Aftermarket nose cone/bumper allowed
- \$100 protest fee-Must be specific on what protesting and can be done by driver in top 5 of another car in top 5 only. Must be done within 5 minutes of feature completion-Money goes to track
- \$500 engine protest rule-must be specific and something not routinely checked-Money goes to the track
- Cars must have all body panels on the car to start the event
- See enduro small car rules for airbox compliance
- ALL BUFFALO RIVER SHORT TRACKERS MUST HAVE TRANSPONDERS IN PALCE FOR 2023 SEASON
